

# Get a Page Rank 10 Backlink today!

Before I show you how to get a Page Rank 10 Backlink, there are a couple of things I'd like to cover.

You may have heard from people who do not have complete knowledge about Search Engine algorithms that leaving your link on an "inner page" that is new or has a low or 0 Page Rank inside of a high Page Rank domain will do your site no good. This is a **fallacy**.

To show that the above statement is false, just do a search in Google for the word **backlinks** without quotes. You will see an article written by me, Angela V. Edwards, on the GoArticles article directory. I have only used backlinks on inner pages of high Page Rank authority sites for this article. My article currently holds the **NUMBER TWO** position in Google out of 13.7 million competing sites, just below Wikipedia. I have done this by using the inner pages of high ranking websites. You can also do a search for the keyword **Angela**. You will find my site in the **number three spot** out of almost 80 million competing sites. I also only used these "inner page" backlinks for that webpage as well.

Matt Cutts, an engineer for Google who acts as Google's Public Relations contact person was asked about the above statement but he couldn't give a straight answer due to the question being too close to Google's algorithm. You will find part of the interview below.

**Stephan Spencer:** OK. So, I guess, a follow on to that would be: a .edu and .gov link, and so forth, has, typically, a more pristine link neighborhood, so it is not just about the PageRank, right? The link neighborhood comes into play.

**Matt Cutts:** That is a little bit of a "secret sauce" question, so I am not going to go into how much we do trust that sort of stuff.

**Stephan Spencer:** OK. I am going to slap my wrist now. Ouch, ouch!

**Matt Cutts:** [laughing]

If you do NOT have a Gmail or Blogger account, go to Gmail and set one up for yourself. A Gmail account will give you access to ALL of Google's features:

**Profiles: About profiles**

A Google profile is simply how you present yourself on Google products to other Google users. It allows you to control how you appear on Google and tell others a bit more about who you are. With a Google profile, you can easily share your web content on one central location. You can include, for example, links to your blog, online photos, and other profiles such as Facebook, LinkedIn, and more. You have control over what others see. Your profile won't display any private information unless you've [explicitly added it](#).

You can also allow people to find you more easily by enabling your profile to be searched by your name. Simply set your existing profile to show your full name publicly.

If you've been writing reviews on Google Maps, creating articles on Google Knol, sharing Google Reader items, or adding books to your Google Book Search library, you may already have a profile. [See and customize your profile](#).

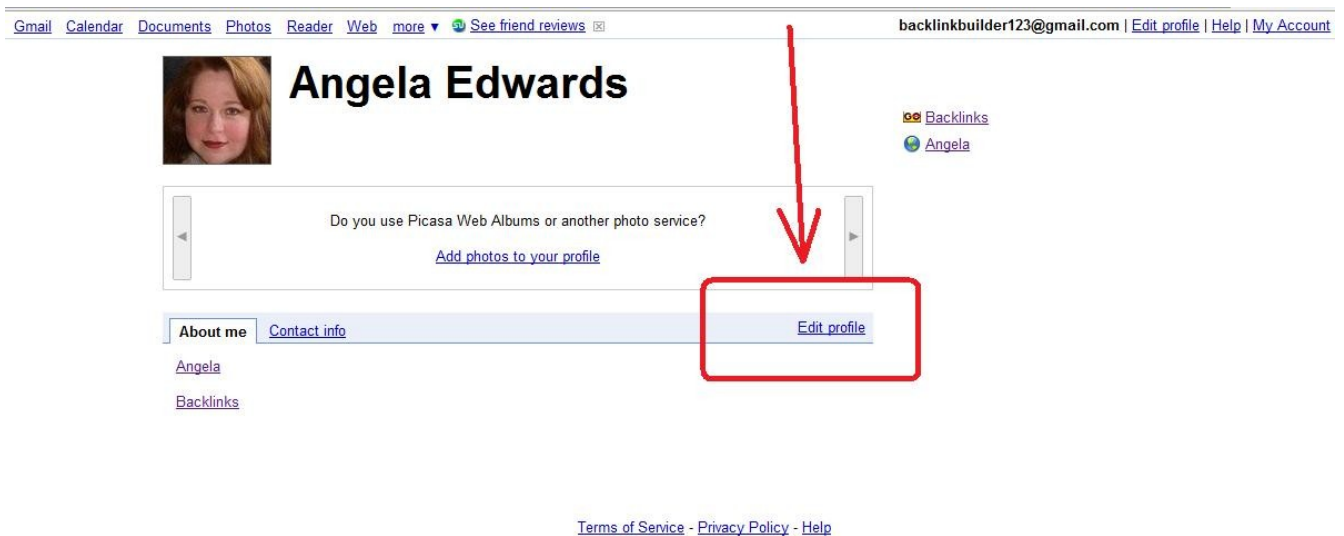

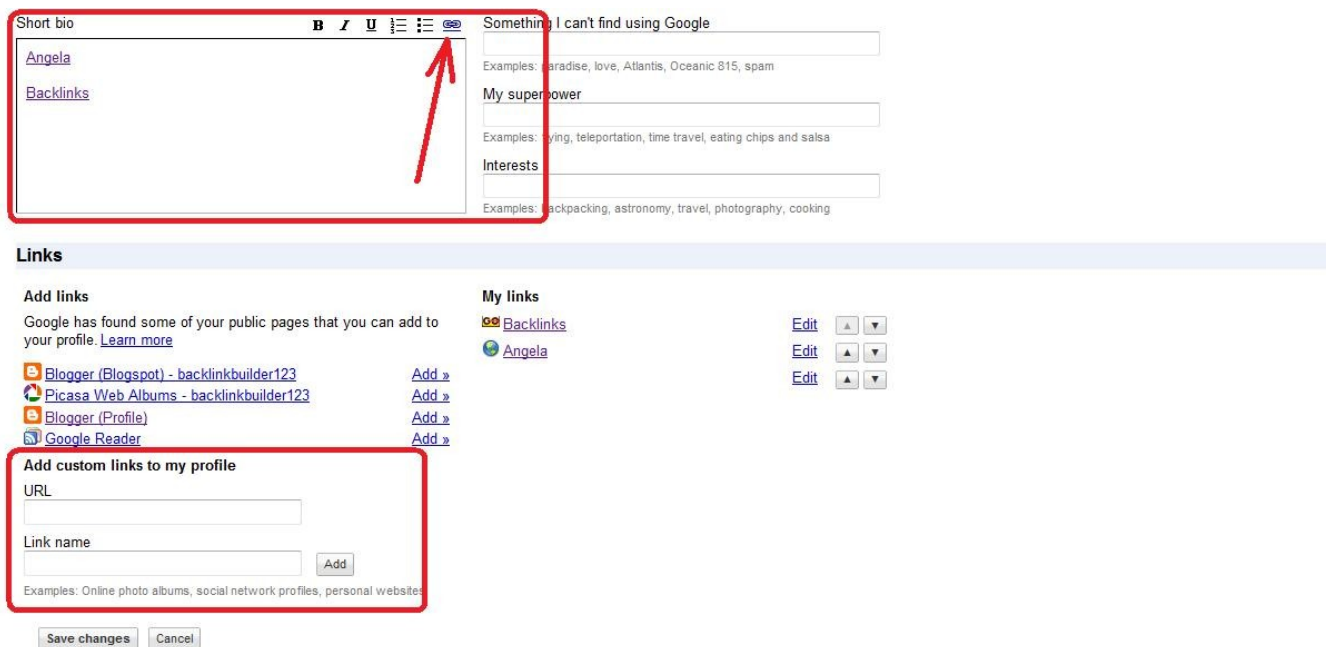

When you get to your profile, click the link that says Edit Profile:



There are actually two ways you can set up links in the Google profile. Google gives you the set up for it, as shown below. You also are given a WYSIWYG editor in the “Short Bio” section so that you can add more links. You can have a BUNCH of links on this site.



Now you will have anchor text links on a Page Rank 10 website.

**If you would like to be given a report just like this, with screenshots of how you can leave your**

link on **30 NEW Do Follow sites** that carry page rank starting at Page Rank 6 and going as high as Page Rank 9 **EVERY MONTH** for only \$5 per month you can sign up here. Remember, that these types of backlinks would cost you *hundreds of dollars* a month any place else.
